The Syllabus: Major Sections

- 1. Introduction: the syllabus, participation, presentations, term paper, and final exam
- 2. Lecturer's Notes on the Rise of short story and novel as modern genres.
- 3. Selected short stories by Edgar Allen Poe, Ernest Hemingway, Franz Kafka, James Joyce, William Faulkner and other major figures in contemporary short story.
- 4. The Scarlet Letter by Nathaniel Hawthorne and A Portrait of the Artist as a Young Man by James Joyce.
- 5. Novels for assignment: *The Picture of Dorian Gray* by Oscar Wilde.

Participation:

Students are required to provide responses to questions concerning the material taught and discussed in the sessions; they are also required to share their comments in class on the material to be taught according to the syllabus.

Presentation:

Each student is required to choose a topic for presentation in class. The presentation is mostly about a particular kind of novel according to the list of the typology of novels presented in the first session.

Term Paper:

Students are required to submit to the lecturer a term paper concerning a close reading of a major novel or short story in terms of a modern critical approach towards the end of the semester. The topic of the term paper should be presented to the lecturer at the beginning of the semester.
